I am directed to invite your kind attention to the letter cited under ref. (i) and to state that, as per the instructions contained therein and in the Manual on Polling Stations, 2020 the DEOs and the EROs of the UT of Puducherry had performed the rationalization of Polling Stations in connection with SIR 2026 as a part of pre-revision activities and furnished their consolidated reports.

2. Based on the report of the DEOs, the approval of the Election Commission of India in respect of rationalisation of Polling Stations of UT of Puducherry was sought for vide letter cited under ref (ii) and the approval was obtained vide letter cited under ref (iii).

3. During the draft electoral roll publication (after the completion of the Enumeration Phase of SIR-2026), an overall reduction of 9.46% of total number of electors was observed in the Union Territory of Puducherry. The initial rationalisation exercise was undertaken based on the pre-enumeration elector strength, which was considerably higher. With the publication of the Draft Roll on 16.12.2025, a clearer and

more accurate assessment of the electorate is available necessitating another round of rationalisation.

4. In view of the above, it is submitted that undertaking rationalisation of Polling Stations before publication of the Final Roll after the culmination of SIR 2026 is essential due to the following reasons:

- i. To optimise the number of Polling Stations that is commensurate with the reduced electorate. This would help in reducing the administrative burden, saves cost, ensure optimal deployment of polling personnel on poll day and reduce vulnerability (as force deployment can be focused).
- ii. To enhance voter convenience by maintaining a maximum distance of 2 km between Polling Stations and voters' residences.
- iii. To address the anomalies in Polling Station locations, public grievances and objections that were received after the publication of the Draft Electoral Roll.
- iv. To correct errors in the 'Section-to-Part' mapping to reduce inconvenience to electors.

5. Further, the O/o CEO, Puducherry has created a GIS Platform to create spatial data layers of Sections and Parts (PS) to carry out the following activities as part of election preparedness for the upcoming Assembly Polls in Puducherry:

- i. Mapping of key geographic features and geo-tagging of all Polling Stations using geo coordinates on Google Maps.
- ii. Development of GIS Layers for Assembly Constituencies, Parts, and Polling Stations.
- iii. GIS-based analysis of voter turnout trends from previous elections.
- iv. Identification of inducement-prone areas, expenditure-sensitive pockets, and other vulnerable zones to facilitate focused monitoring and ensure comprehensive preparedness for forthcoming elections.

Further, BLOs were trained and assigned the task of capturing GPS coordinates for each section within their respective parts by physically traversing all sections and generating GIS (KML) files for the same. Based on this exercise, a comprehensive digital map of all Sections, Parts (PS) and Assembly Constituencies was created for the Union Territory of Puducherry. Anomalous sections were identified and merged with adjacent parts. Sections were also rationalised among neighboring parts to reduce the overall number of parts, while ensuring that the prescribed ceiling of 1,200 electors per Polling Station is not exceeded.

6. Based on this exercise, the DEOs had submitted reports cited under ref (iv) & (v) with the following changes:

7. Further, the report of the DEOs include: -

- Details of consultations with representatives of political parties, along with the Minutes of the meeting held with them.
- Certification that: -
  - No polling station is in a dilapidated building, or in a religious place or within 200 metres of the office of a political party.
  - All infrastructures like ramp, drinking water, toilet facility, shade, shelter, etc., are available in these rationalized / modified polling stations.
  - No vulnerable section of society is under threat or intimidation to access the polling stations.
  - Draft list of Polling Stations rationalized in UT of Puducherry, as per the instructions contained in the Manual on Polling Station, 2020 of the Election Commission of India has been published and displayed in the respective Offices of the District Election Officer, Puducherry and Karaikal and Electoral Registration Officers of Puducherry and Karaikal and certificate to this effect is enclosed.

8. The proposals have been made after physical verification and discussion with the representatives of the recognised political parties as per the instructions contained in chapter 4 the Manual on Polling Stations. The EROs have obtained the consent of the owners of the private buildings for the newly proposed locations of the Polling

Stations and have ensured that the owners of the private buildings are not affiliated with any political party.

9. The proposals have been scrutinised and found to be in order. Accordingly, to incorporate the above-mentioned changes, it is proposed to conduct rationalisation of Polling Stations in the Union Territory of Puducherry before the publication of the Final Electoral Roll on 14.02.2026.

10. Therefore, it is requested that necessary approval of the Election Commission of India in respect of rationalisation of Polling Stations of UT of Puducherry as detailed above may kindly be obtained and communicated at the earliest.

11. This issues with the approval of the Chief Electoral Officer.

I am to inform that, the Election Commission of India (ECI) has directed a re-rationalisation of polling stations in the Puducherry District. While the ECI had previously approved a rationalisation plan that increased the number of stations from 782 to 918, the Draft publication of the Special Intensive Revision-2026 revealed a significant reduction in the electorate. Specifically, 85,531 voters were deleted due to death, permanent shifting, or absentee status, leading to a decrease in voter density across many existing stations.

2. In response to these changes, the Electoral Registration Officers (EROs) have proposed a comprehensive modification of the polling station layout. The recommendations include the change of location for 21 stations, the change of nomenclature for 69 stations, and the re-organisation of 515 stations. Furthermore, while 3 new polling stations are proposed for creation, 78 stations are recommended for deletion. These adjustments will result in a final count of 840 polling stations, down from the previously approved 918.

3. The proposed re-rationalisation strictly adheres to ECI mandates, ensuring that no polling station is located in a private residence, no voter travels more than 2 km, and no political party office is within 200 metres of a station. During the deliberations, representatives from the recognized National and State political parties expressed their satisfaction with these changes and welcomed the overall reduction in the number of stations.

4. I am therefore to enclose herewith the proposal submitted by EROs in the Annexure.

5. I am therefore, to request that necessary approval of ECI for the above said rationalisation of polling stations may please be obtained and conveyed to this office.

MINUTES OF THE MEETING CONDUCTED BY THE DISTRICT ELECTION OFFICER, PUDUCHERRY ON 04.02.2026 AT 04:00P.M. IN THE CONFERENCE HALL, DISTRICT COLLECTORATE, PUDUCHERRY.

A meeting under the chairmanship of the District Election Officer, Puducherry, was held on 04.02.2026 at 04.00 p.m. in the Conference Hall, District Collectorate, Puducherry, with the EROs and representatives of recognised National/State Political Parties in connection with the re-rationalisation of polling stations in Puducherry District.

2. The list of representatives of recognised National/State Political Parties who attended the meeting is annexed.

3. At the outset, the District Election Officer welcomed all the officials and representatives of recognised National/State Political Parties present at the meeting. The DEO briefed that, before the Draft roll publication in Special Intensive Revision-2026, the Election Commission of India had instructed the rationalisation of polling stations having more than 1,200 electors. Accordingly, proposals for rationalisation of polling stations in the Assembly Constituencies of Puducherry District were submitted to the ECI, and the same were approved by the ECI, wherein the following recommendations were approved:

- a) Change of location: 32 polling stations.
- b) Change of nomenclature: 110 polling stations
- c) Re-organisation: 381 polling stations
- d) Creation of new polling stations: 120 new polling stations

Thus, the total number of polling stations increased from 782 to 918.

4. Further, the DEO explained that during the Draft publication of the Special Intensive Revision-2026, 85,531 voters were deleted due to death, permanent shifting, and absentee voters. Hence, there was a reduction in the total number of voters in many polling stations. Therefore, the ECI directed the conduct of re-rationalisation of polling stations. Accordingly, the procedure adopted for the rationalisation of polling stations was as follows:

- a) No polling station shall be housed in a private residential building.
- b) Polling stations shall be set up in such a way that no voter is required to travel more than 2 km for voting.
- c) No political party office shall be located within 200 metres of a polling station.
- d) Polling stations shall be located at the most convenient, accessible, and well-known places for resident electors.

5. Further, all EROs briefly explained to the representatives of recognised National/State Political Parties the list of polling stations requiring modification/changes and the creation of new polling stations, along with the reasons for such changes, as detailed below:

- a) Change of location: 21 polling stations recommended by the EROs
- b) Change of nomenclature: 69 polling stations recommended by the EROs
- c) Re-organisation: 515 polling stations recommended by the EROs
- d) Creation of new polling stations: 3 new polling stations recommended by the EROs
- e) Deletion of polling stations: 78 polling stations deleted, thereby reducing the total number of polling stations from 918 to 840.

6. The representatives of Political Parties requested the sharing of soft and hard copies of the rationalisation proposals to sensitise the voters.

7. The DEO agreed to furnish the draft rationalisation proposal copies to the representatives of recognised National/State Political Parties.


8. Further, the DEO explained the details of Logical Discrepancy cases and the Hon'ble Supreme Court judgment, and informed that, in compliance with the judgment, all EROs would furnish the Logical Discrepancy cases of their Assembly Constituencies to the political parties. The details of all Logical Discrepancy cases have been uploaded on the official website of the DEO, Puducherry. The DEO also explained the Logical Discrepancy cases and invited the representatives of Political Parties to participate in the disposal of these cases at the earliest.

9. After due deliberations, the representatives of Political Parties expressed their satisfaction with the proposals relating to the change of location of polling stations, change of nomenclature, and creation of polling stations, subject to minor modifications, and welcomed the reduction in the number of polling stations from 918 to 840.

10. With this, the meeting came to an end with a vote of thanks from the District Election Officer.
